All Kata will be flags and double elimination. All Kumite will be San Bon (3 ippon or 6 Wazari).

Advance (Black Belt over 18 years old will be charter and each time will be a different kata).

Kumite will be San Bon (3 ippon or 6 Wazari).

Senior Black Belts (will be 34 years old and above score kata) and Kumite San Bon (3 ippon or 6 Wazari).

Equipment under 18 years old - Helmet with shield, White Gloves preferred, Mouth Piece, Groin Protection & Chest Protection Optional

Equipment over 18 years old - Mouth Piece, Gloves & Helmet Optional

Waiver and Release of Liability
